

PCFitment's Commission-Based Affiliate Program is specially designed to motivate affiliate marketers who can onboard new customers while ensuring long-term growth and engagement. This document outlines the commission structure, payout rules, compliance requirements, and additional policies to ensure transparency and efficiency.

Affiliate Registration Process



User Tracking via Cookies

- When a user clicks on an affiliate's link, PCFitment sets a cookie in their browser for 90 days.
- If the user registers within this period, they are attributed to the affiliate.
- The cookie duration may be adjusted (e.g., 30, 60, 120 days).

Affiliate Attribution Rules

- If a user clicks multiple affiliate links, the most recent affiliate receives credit.
For example, If a user initially registers through John Martin (Affiliate 1) and later registers through Rose Mure, the final affiliate associated with the user will be Rose Mure.
- Once a user registers under an affiliate, they remain linked to that affiliate for life.
- The commission is credited only when the referred user completes a payment.



Commission Structure

The commission percentage depends on the number of onboarded accounts. Higher tiers offer better rewards.

Tier	Accounts Onboarded	Commission Rate
Basic	1 - 25	10%
Standard	26 - 50	15% for 26 to 50 accounts only
Premium	>50	20% for >50 accounts only

* PCFitment reserves the right to **increase or decrease** the commission structure in the future, but it wouldn't affect existing active affiliates.

Affiliate Reactivation & Commission

- » If PCFitment changes the commission structure, the old affiliates will continue to follow the old commission structure, while the new commission structure will apply to new affiliates.
- » If an affiliate is **inactive for a period** and then reactivates, they will follow **the latest commission structure** set by PCFitment at the time of reactivation.

Minimum Performance Requirement

To continue receiving commissions, affiliates must maintain a minimum onboarding rate:



Additional Scenarios

- » If an affiliate **fails in Q1** but starts in **Q2**, the System evaluates their performance before reactivating them.
- » If in **Q1 + Q2**, the affiliate brings **6 users**, and in **Q3** they bring **3 more**, the system recognizes them as **active**.
- » If an affiliate brings **16 users in the first half of the year**, they are **active for the full year**.
- » If an affiliate brings **2 users in Q1**, they become **temporarily inactive** but can reactivate by bringing **1 more user (i.e. total 6)** in Q2.
- » If an affiliate brings **6 users in the first half but none in Q2**, they remain active until Q3.

Payment & Withdrawal Policy

» **Minimum Balance:**

Affiliates can withdraw commissions **only when their balance exceeds \$100.**

» **Holding Period:**

Commissioned funds remain in an **Unwithdrawable** Balance for 30 days before release.

» **Payment Methods:**

Direct Bank Transfer, PayPal, or other approved methods.

» **Processing Time:**

Payments are made within **7-10 business days** after a withdrawal request.

- » If an **affiliate becomes inactive**, commissions earned from new users are **accumulated but cannot be withdrawn.** However, older commissions remain withdrawable.

Inactive Affiliate & Payment Rules

- » If an affiliate becomes **inactive**, commissions continue accruing, but **withdrawals are locked.**
- » Affiliates **cannot** refer **existing PCFitment customers** as new sign-ups.
- » Once agent reactivated we will allow him to withdraw old and new all commission.

Compliance & Fraud Prevention

- » PCFitment reserves the right to **withhold commissions** for fraudulent, inactive, or non-compliant accounts.
- » Affiliates must not **create fake accounts** or **register low-value customers** to inflate commissions.
- » Violating these rules may result in **immediate suspension** from the program.

Trial-to-Paid Conversions

- » If an affiliate converts a **trial user** into a **paid customer**, they receive full commission.
- » PCFitment may provide a list of customers from the last 30 days who were on a 14-day trial to a genuine affiliate who has been working well with PCFitment for a long time.

Reasons for Inactivation

- » Affiliate engages in wrongful activity.
- » PCFitment identifies violations.

Commission Calculation Scenario

Scenario 1

- » An affiliate signs up 30 users.
- » For the first 25 users, they receive **10% commission**.
- » For the next 5 users (26-30), they receive **15% commission**.

Scenario 2

- » The affiliate reaches 51 users.
- » Users **1-25** → **10%** commission.
- » Users **26-50** → **15%** commission.
- » Users **51 and above** → **20%** commission.

Scenario 3

- » If an affiliate has **40 users** but **10 become inactive**, their total active users drop to 30.
- » Their commission recalculates, so users **1-25** earn **10%**, and users **26-30** earn **15%**.

Scenario 4

(Inactive Users Affecting Commission Tiers)

- » If **2 users from the first 25 become inactive**, users **26 and 27** move down to positions **24 and 25**. This means their commission rate **drops back to 10%**.
- » If the above 2 inactive user will become an active user again and will return to their original position. The 24th & the 25th user will move to the 26 & 27 position, and their commission will start at 15% as per the commission structure.
- » Daily recalculations adjust the commission structure dynamically.
